



WHO WE ARE

The Worcester Talking Book Library loans reading materials in accessible formats including large print, braille, and digital talking books.



WHO IS ELIGIBLE

Massachusetts residents of any age are eligible for these free services if they struggle to read traditional print materials due to a visual, physical, or reading disability. Patrons can access these free resources via postage-free mail or by download to the free BARD (Braille and Audio Reading Download) app. Accounts are also available for qualifying institutions such as schools, libraries, or assisted living facilities.

- Access to audiobooks through easy-to-use equipment OR your own tablet or phone
- Large print books for all ages
- Programs and workshops
- A public space equipped with a study room and computers with accessibility features
- Braille books
- Audio-described DVDs
- Children's services from WonderBooks to beginner's braille, to large print and audiobooks
- Deposit collections for qualifying institutions
- Information on new releases and book recommendations
- Dial-A-Story: select stories, poems, and a recording of our newsletter from your phone
